Job Responsibilities:

Reporting to the Manager of Mechanical Inspections, responsibilities will include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Review and inspect the Plumbing and HVAC systems of Part 9 residential buildings to ensure conformance with the OBC and related standards.
- Ensure that the professionals undertaking general review of construction, where required by code, do so in accordance with legislated standards.
- Ensure compliance with local by-laws and Provincial codes, through oral and written communications.
- Produce legible, concise, complete, and accurate reports; maintain a record of field inspections.
- Liaise with property owners, contractors, engineers, architects and other departments on matters related to construction activity.
- Investigate and respond to building complaints from the public relating to the Ontario Building Code
- Prepare and issue legal documents and attend court in legal proceedings.
- Monitor an assigned area for building construction and/or alterations without a permit.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Successful completion of a Community College Diploma in Mechanical Engineering or equivalent combination of education and experience in the plumbing and HVAC construction industry.
- Possess the mandatory Provincial Qualifications in General Legal/Process, Plumbing House and HVAC – House.
- Minimum 1 year of experience as a Municipal Mechanical (Plumbing and HVAC) Inspector on Part 9
 residential buildings or 3 years of relevant experience in mechanical system design and construction
 fields with an in-depth knowledge of the Ontario Building Code.
- Current plumber license and/or sheet metal worker license will be an asset.
- Excellent organizational, verbal, written and interpersonal skills are essential as well as the ability to deal effectively with the public.
- Proficient in the use of computer technologies and being familiar with Microsoft Office Suite of Products.
- Travel to a variety of sites is required. The successful candidate will be required to supply their own
 personal vehicle for performing job duties/corporate business, transportation costs will be reimbursed at
 Town rates.
- Successful candidates, who are new hires and/or who have not performed in this position previously
 will be required to provide a satisfactory criminal record check dated within the last 30 days as a
 condition of employment.
